Main research on economic disparities and trade in the Habsburg Monarchy between the 18th and 20th century.

The prize, donated by the Berlin family of scholars Kuczynski, is named after the German economist **Robert René Kuczynski** (1876-1947), whose demographic studies became particularly famous in the Anglo-American region.
